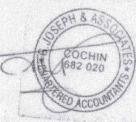

- 2 The Company has reported a total comprehensive loss of Rs. 72.22 lakhs during the current period and has accumulated losses amounting to Rs. 1892.23 lakhs as on 30th

The net worth of the company has eroded. However, the Company has performed an assessment of liquidity and going concern assumption, recoverable values of its financial and non-financial assets, including overdue receivables from various customers, and impact on revenues and costs. Based on astimates and assumptions used in business forecast and fund flow projections, management expects to recover the carrying amount of the assets and will be able to discharge the liabilities.

- 3 Prior period comparatives have been regrouped / reclassified wherever necessary to conform to the presentation in the current period and are compliant with Ind AS. The management has exercised necessary due diligence to ensure that the financial results give a true and fair view.
- 4 The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on 10th November and the Limited Review of the same has been carried out by the statutory auditors.

#### To the Board of Directors of Eastern Treads Limited

- We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Financial Results of Eastern Treads Limited (the "Company"), for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 (the "Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, (as amended), including relevant circulars issued by SEBI from time to time.
